This nationally accredited qualification provides participants with the training, skills and knowledge to select, install, set up, test, fault find, repair and maintain electrical systems and equipment in buildings and premises and includes the ERAC requirements for an Electrician's Licence. The program directly supports the WA Electrical Mechanic Apprenticeship.

REQUIREMENTS

This qualification is delivered under Australian apprenticeship arrangements.

DURATION

40 weeks per year over a period of 4 years.
