OVERVIEW

Equip-Safe's Construction Industry Preparation Skill Set provides essential training for individuals seeking to work in, or for those working in the electrotechnology, construction, plumbing and services, renewables and clean energies, resources, mining, and infrastructure industries.

You'll learn how to operate an elevating work platform (scissor lift), safely operate self-propelled boom lifts (under 11 metres), work at heights, and apply workplace safety practices in various industry settings.

Completion of this skill set results in a Statement of Attainment, which can contribute to further qualifications, including Certificate II, Certificate III, Certificate IV, Diploma, and Advanced Diploma qualifications.
