

How to apply for an electrical apprenticeship at EGT

The recruitment process at EGT is both specialised and competitive. EGT carefully assess applicants to ensure they have the right combination of skills, aptitude and attitude to be successful in the electrical trade.

✓ STEP 1

Ensure you have copies of the following documents to submit with your online application:

- ✓ Birth certificate or proof of residency
- ✓ USI number
- ✓ Drivers Licence
- ✓ White card
- ✓ Colour vision test result
(available at any optometrist)

✓ STEP 2

EGT will email you regarding the status of your application.

Scan the QR code to create an account online and book your National Readiness Assessment (NRA).



You can book your chosen date through the online portal and complete the test at EGT Balcatta.

In the meantime, you can practice the test on the online portal.

✓ STEP 3

If successful, EGT will contact you to arrange your Pre-Employment Assessments.

This involves:

- An introduction to WHS practices
- Electrician's Training Licence assessment
- Hand skills assessment

You must provide EGT with your police clearance and drug screen on the day of your Pre-Employment Assessments.

✓ OFFER

Should you successfully complete EGT's Pre-Employment Assessments, EGT may present you with an offer of employment.

✓ EGT INDUCTION

Congratulations and welcome to the EGT team! EGT's four day induction covers everything you need to start working as an electrical apprentice.

EGT Electrical Apprenticeship Job Application Checklist



Birth certificate or Proof of residency

You must be under 21 years of age.



Drivers Licence

A manual licence is preferred, however an automatic or provisional licence is acceptable.



USI Number

Your Unique Student Identifier, provided by the federal government.



White card

A white card is necessary for all construction sites in WA.



Pre-apprenticeship or National Readiness Assessment (NRA)

Certificate II in Electrotechnology or Data and Voice. Other Certificate II courses are assessed on a case by case basis. If you don't have a Certificate II, a National Readiness Assessment is required.



Colour vision test result

An Ishihara colour vision test is available from any optometrist. Please contact us if you receive a fail result for information about additional test options.



Drug screen

Requested upon your invitation to the EGT pre-employment session.
